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## Errata Sheet: Virginia’s Plan for Well-Being 2016-2020

### AIM 1 — Healthy, Connected Communities

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**Page 6 and 11** “By 2020, the Consumer Opportunity Index score in Virginia increases from 81.8% to 83.7%”  
“By 2020, the Economic Opportunity Index score in Virginia increases from 70.7% to 73.7%”

**Corrections** The Consumer and Economic Opportunity should be referred to as a profile and not an index. The Consumer Opportunity Profile is available here:

On page 11, under measures of success the data years for the Consumer and Economic Opportunity Profiles are noted to be from 2009 to 2013. The Consumer and Economic Opportunity Profiles utilize data from various sources, including the American Community Survey (ACS) - 5 year estimates. The ACS- 5 year estimates were used to derive a point estimate for each profile. The data years for both the Consumer and Economic Profiles should be labelled as 2013. This methodology will continue to be used going forward (e.g. 2014 will use data from 2010-2014).

### AIM 3 — Preventive Actions

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**Page 27** The figure for Adults Vaccinated Against Influenza notes the data year as 2014.

### AIM 4 — System of Health Care

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**Page 7 and 36** “By 2020, the rate of avoidable deaths from heart disease, stroke, or hypertensive disease in Virginia decreases from 46.76 to 40.00 per 100,000 persons”

**Correction** “By 2020, the rate of avoidable deaths from heart disease, stroke, or hypertensive disease in Virginia decreases from 49.99 to 40.00 per 100,000 persons”

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**Page 39** The figure for Providers with Electronic Health Records notes the data year as 2015.

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**Page 7 and 41** “By 2020, the percentage of hospitals in Virginia meeting the state goal for prevention of hospital-onset Clostridium difficile infections increases from 36% to 100%.”

**Correction** Correction: “By 2020, the percentage of hospitals in Virginia meeting the state goal for prevention of hospital-onset Clostridium difficile infections increases from 38.5% to 100%.”
